Vineyard area : 0,75 acres.

Density of plantation : 4000 vines per acre.

Farming : Organic Farming without certification.

Winemaking : Semi-carbonic maceration with whole clusters at low temperature for 18 days in concrete vat. Fermentation under native yeasts and without sulfites..

Aging : 6 months in oak barrels.

Bright red ruby robe. A very fresh and energetic bouquet on the nose displaying ripe red berry and floral notes with a touch of spices. Juicy and sweet in the mouth, offering raspberry and cherry flavors, a long finish with very fine tannins.
