

FLEURIE LES CHENES 2011 LUCIEN LARDY

91 Points | International Wine Cellar , July 2013

Brilliant ruby. Sexy, floral red fruit preserve scents are lifted and sharpened by a smoky mineral quality. Incisive, appealingly sweet raspberry and cherry flavors gain weight with air while maintaining vibrancy. The floral quality comes back on the finish, which lingers with very good mineral-driven persistence.



MOULIN A VENT 2011 RICHARD ROTTIERS

90 Points | International Wine Cellar , July 2013

Bright purple. Pungent aromas of cherry pit and violet, with a smoky mineral topnote. Starts off chewy and broad but tightens up with air, offering gently sweet dark fruit flavors and a touch of floral pastille. The smoky note returns on the finish, which features fine-grained tannins and a hint of bitter chocolate.



MORGON GRANDS CRAS 2011 LAURENT GAUTHIER

90 Points | International Wine Cellar , July 2013

Bright violet color. Deeply pitched dark berry and floral pastille aromas are enlivened by smoky minerals and Asian spices. Chewy and broad on entry, then tighter in the mid-palate, offering bitter cherry and blackcurrant flavors plus a hint of succulent herbs. Closes firm and long, with lingering spiciness and a suggestion of violet.



REGNIE HAUTE RONZE 2011 Jean-Michel DUPRE

89 Points | International Wine Cellar , July 2013

Vivid red. Pungent mineral- and spice-accented scents of cherry and cassis, with a hint of licorice in the background. Taut, linear and light on its feet, showing good clarity and lift to its tangy dark fruit flavors. Finishes with a light touch and smooth, even tannins that add grip.



MORGON COTE DU PY 2010 Domaine La Bonne Tonne – Marcel GRILLET

89 Points | International Wine Cellar , July 2013

Bright ruby. Dark berries and cherry pit on the pungent nose and in the mouth. Chewy and refreshingly bitter, with slow-building sweetness and a touch of licorice on the tangy finish. This wine benefits quite a bit from aeration.



MORGON LE GRIOTTIER 2011 Jean-Michel DUPRE

88 Points | International Wine Cellar , July 2013

Brilliant ruby. Sharply focused redcurrant and cherry aromas are complicated by notes of anise, smoky minerals and black tea. Tangy and incisive on the palate, offering bitter cherry and herb flavors and a hint of orange pith. Closes with good clarity and cut, with firm tannins adding grip.
