## Beaujolais-Villages Blanc - Terres Blanches -

### Origin

Beaujolais Blanc is the most rare of Beaujolais, only 3% of the total production in the region. 100% Chardonnay grown on a white clay soil giving the name "Terres Blanches" to the cuvee.

### From the vines...

**Varietal:** 100% Chardonnay

**Density of plantation:** 2500 vines per acre

**Vine Age:** 14 years old

**Soil type:** Clay and granit

**Elevation:** 280m

**Exposure:** East-West, South-North

**Farming:** Estate certified HVE. Sustainable farming favoring the biodiversity, working the soil

**Winemaking:** Manual harvest. Direct pneumatic press. Fermentation under temperature control in tank. Cold settling for 48 hours..

**Aging:** Partial aging in neutral oak barrels and the rest in stainless steel tank.

### ... To the glass

Bright yellow golden robe. A nose displaying green apple, white flower and almond notes. Very fresh and clean in the palate, with a well-balanced acidity and minerality

### Food pairings

Pair with fish, scallops, crab legs or crab cakes, cheese or poultry with cream
