Fleurie *Beaujolais Cru since 1936* - Les Moriers -

Origin

Vines aged of one century in a magic terroir. Did you know it? The plot Les Moriers was classified 1er Cru in 1874.

From the vines...

Varietal : 100% Gamay Noir.

Vineyard area : 2,25 acres.

Density of plantation : 3600 vines per acre.

Vine Age : 110 years old.

Plot : « Les Moriers ».

Soil type : Pink granite and sand.

Elevation : 240m.

Exposure : East.

Farming : Sustainable farming, short pruning in bushes.

Winemaking : 12 days maceration with whole clusters in gridded vats, fermentation under native yeasts.

Aging : Aged for 12 months in neutral oak barrels.

... To the glass

Bright garnet robe. The nose is very pure, characterized with violette flowers and blackcurrant. The mouth is full of blackberries and racy notes, with a long and bright finish!
