Origin

The pink granite rocks gush in this area, a promess for minerality and ripeness thanks to the warmth kept by the rocks.

From the vines...

Varietal : 100% Gamay Noir.

Vineyard area : 15 acres.

Density of plantation : 4000 vines per acre.

Vine Age : 67 years old.

Plot : « Les Roches ».

Soil type : Pink granite with sand.

Elevation : 280m.

Exposure : South and South east.

Farming : Sustainable farming, short pruning in bushes, putting straw in the vines.

Winemaking : 12 days maceration with whole clusters in gridded vats, fermentation under native yeasts.

Aging : Aged for 8 months in concrete vats.

Clarification : Light filtration.

... To the glass

Red garnet robe with purple tints. The nose is complexe with ripe wild berries, roasted and floral notes. The palate is very velvety, with a long and silky finish. The tannins are fine and sweet.

Food pairings

Good with roasted chicken or turkey, white meat skewers, grilled fished, cheese.
