Origin

Thanks to an hard work, Lucien LARDY became a sure value in Fleurie. This plot ideally located was a good opportunity to take a new challenge for quality in the Moulin à Vent appellation.

From the vines...

Varietal : 100% Gamay Noir.

Vineyard area : 7,5 acres.

Density of plantation : 4000 vines per acre.

Vine Age : 70 years old.

Plot : « Les Thorins ».

Soil type : Granite and sand with veins of manganese (iron mineral).

Elevation : 260m.

Exposure : South-east.

Farming : Sustainable farming, short pruning in bushes.

Winemaking : 12 days maceration with whole clusters in gridded vats, fermentation under native yeasts.

Aging : Aged for 8 months in vats and 15% in neutral oak barrels.

Clarification : Light filtration.

... To the glass

Red crimson robe. Complexe and spicy notes with blueberries and violette flowers. A rich wine, musky and mineral characterized with a silky and round finish!

Food pairings

Try it with cassoulet, duck confit, games, lamb, roasted chicken.
