Fleurie *Beaujolais Cru since 1936* - Les Chênes -

Origin

The son of Lucien LARDY, Yoahn influenced the winemaking of this Fleurie. He tried to extract fresh berries and to soften the tannins with a long aging in neutral oak barrels.

From the vines...

Varietal : 100% Gamay Noir.

Vineyard area : 3 acres.

Density of plantation : 4000 vines per acre.

Vine Age : 72 years old.

Plot : « Les Chênes ».

Soil type : Sand and pink granite.

Elevation : 280m.

Exposure : South.

Farming : Sustainable farming, short pruning in bushes, putting straw in the vines.

Winemaking : Hand picked grapes, 4 days storage of the grapes in a fridge under 5°C, maceration in whole cluster for 13 days, fermentation with native yeasts between 20 and 25°C.

Aging : One year in neutral oak.

Clarification : Light filtration.

... To the glass

Red garnet robe with purple tints. The nose is displaying grapey and blackcurrant notes, with iris flowers. The mouth is full, and rich, with a tender smoothness, blackfruits, floral and spicy notes. A nice mineral backbone and a bright and fruity finish!
